Please note you have to attend the school for 11 months to get your 12th month free - if you start in February then January 2019 is free not December 2018!

We will be participating in the Alberton Eisteddfod this year taking place from 8 –18 August 2018.


Thank you to all our participants. We are very excited. We have enrolled 16 children from our school. Our Grade R class will also participate in a prescribed poem.
